





# Paper Placement & Pencil Skills


#### **LEFT-HANDED**

Place the **left** corner higher.



#### **RIGHT-HANDED**

Place the **right** corner higher.




Eraser points to left shoulder.



Standard grip: Hold pencil with thumb + index finger. Pencil rests on middle finger.



Alternate grip: Hold pencil with thumb + index and middle fingers. Pencil rests on ring finger.
